Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The total number of sections of Bal vatika shall be restricted to 3(1 section each for Bal Vatika I, II & III respectively).The total number of sections from classes I to XII shall be restricted to 16. Any further increase shall require prior permission of the Board and shall be subject to compliance with the affiliation Bye laws and availability of rooms of >500 sq ft dimensions.
2	The wash basin is not there inside the cubicle of girls CwSN toilets. The CwSN toilets are not seen on every floor. Thus, the school is required to construct the CwSN toilets separately for boys and girls on each floor with sufficient space for easy movement of the wheelchair as well as handrail on both side of toilet seat (fixed and movable) and proper permanent signage (on the cubicle indicating the floor number) as per norms of RPwD Act and board's guidelines within 03 months and submit the compliance.
3	Seating facility in computer lab is in appropriate (stools). Hence the school is directed to upgrade computer lab as per SoP issued by the Board and submit the compliance within 3 months.
4	The school does not have EPF facility for its staff. However the school has given an undertaking on 18-04-2024 through email wherein it is stated that the school will continue remittance towards EPF w.e.f. 01-04-2024 i.e. from the salary for the month of April 2024 to be paid in May 2024. Hence the school is directed to make the EPF

	facility available for all its staff as per EPFO guidelines and submit the documentary evidence on SARAS portal within 3 months.
5	The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Ajmer within 3 months and submit the compliance.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII , as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted within the stipulated 3 months , the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.

In this connection, I am directed to convey approval of the Board for land increase/decrease as per the details mentioned below on the basis of online documents and data uploaded by school.

Sl. No.	CONDITIONS
1	The school may ensure the size of all classrooms (sections) must be as per Affiliation Bye laws of the board, 2018/ norms i.e. 500 sq ft.
2	School is advised to renew all essential and safety certificates from time to time as per the formats and guidelines issued by the Board.
3	Now, the School will run on 7786 square meters of land area only. If, in future, any increase or decrease in land area of school, school will take permission from the Board as per prevailing norms.

The school is directed to ensure that:-

1. The land on which the school is located should necessarily be a contiguous single plot of land. If there are more than two survey numbers etc. all the survey numbers/plots should be adjacent/touching each other and shall make a single plot of land on the whole.
2. Concrete/Pucca boundary wall of not less than 6 ft height, enclosing the school campus/site.
